Plan to Use Title Funds

Title IA- Improving Basic Programs: \$349,696.00

Funds will be used to provide Math and Read/Write Expert Teachers and Teacher Apprentices. This aligns with Goal 2 and 1 of our Targeted Improvement Plan: (2) In the 2023-2024 school year, Third Future Schools students will grow 1.7 times the average U.S. growth in math as measured by the NWEA MAP assessment and using the mean RIT score for each grade, 2-8. (1) In the 2023-2024 school year, Third Future Schools students will grow 1.7 times the average U.S. growth in reading as measured by the NWEA MAP assessment and using the mean RIT score for each grade, 2-8.

Title I: Parent Engagement: \$4,760.00

Funds will be used to work with parents to implement courses to support community service projects, provide student experiences related to DYAD requirements, send students on field , out of state and out of country trips. We also understand that effective learning must happen at home. Therefore, we work with parents so that we can reach our student achievement goals. We plan to host parent meetings, parent-teacher conferences, volunteer opportunities and offer classroom observations, and family friendly events. Title IIA- Supporting Effective Instruction: \$57,298.00

Funds will be used to provide a Science Teacher Apprentice to provide job embedded professional learning in Science. This aligns with Goal 3 of our Targeted Improvement Plan: In the 2023-2024 school year, Third Future Schools students will grow 1.7 times the average U.S. growth in science as measured by the NWEA MAP assessment and using the mean RIT score for each grade, 2-8.

Title IIIA- Language Instruction for English Learners: \$52,056.00

Funds will be used to provide staff to ensure English learners attain English proficiency and develop high levels of academic achievement in English. This aligns with goal 4 of our Targeted Improvement Plan: In the 2023-2024 school year, Third Future Schools' median growth percentile on the CMAS/STAAR/LEAP exam for English Language Arts for English Language Learners will exceed 55.

Title III-Immigrant: Language Instruction for Immigrants: \$4,590.00

Funds will be used to provide supplies and materials to ensure Immigrant students attain English proficiency and develop high levels of academic achievement in English. This aligns with goal 4 of our Targeted Improvement Plan: In the 2023-2024 school year, Third Future Schools' median growth percentile on the CMAS/STAAR/LEAP exam for English Language Arts for English Language Learners will exceed 55.

Title IVA-Student Support and Academic Enrichment: \$27,680.00

Funds will be used to provide a Art of Thinking Teacher . This aligns with Goal 5 of our Targeted Improvement Plan: 65% of the students in grades 3 through 8 will be proficient in critical thinking as measured by the Third Future Schools end-of-year Art of Thinking exams.
